

TRIVIA QUIZ COOKIES POLICY

Last updated 27 March 2020

Trivia Quiz (**TQ**) is a trivia quiz game (**TQ App, website, site, App, we, us**) created for individual users (**Users, you, your, they, their**) through its website and downloadable software application.

“Trivia Quiz” means On Point Holdings Pty Ltd ACN 618 965 807 its affiliates or related entities.

The following sets out TQ’s Cookie Policy. This policy is to be in conjunction with our Terms and Conditions and Privacy Policy.

COOKIES:

1 WHAT IS A COOKIE?

A cookie is a small amount of data generated by a website and saved by your web browser. Its purpose is to remember information about you, similar to a preference file created by a software application.

While cookies serve many functions, their most common purpose is to store login information for a specific site. Some sites will save your username and password in a cookie, while others will only save your username. Whenever you check a box that says, “Remember me on this computer,” the website will generate a login cookie once you successfully log in. Each time you revisit the website, you may only need to enter your password or might not need to log in at all.

Cookies are also used to store user preferences for a specific site. For example, a search engine may store your search settings in a cookie. A news website may use a cookie to save a custom text size you select for viewing news articles. Financial websites may sometimes use cookies to store recently viewed stock quotes. If a website needs to store a lot of personal information, it may use a cookie to remember who you are, but will load the information from the web server. This method is called “Server Side” storage as is often used when you create an account on a website.

Browser cookies come in 2 different types, “Session” and “Persistent”. Session cookies are temporary and are deleted when the browser is closed. These types of cookies are used often by ecommerce sites to store items placed in your shopping cart, and can serve many other purposes as well. Persistent cookies are designed to store data for an extended period of time. Each Persistent cookie is created with an expiration date, which may be anywhere from a few days to several years in the future. Once the expiration date is reached, the cookie is automatically deleted. Persistent cookies are what allow websites to “remember you” for two weeks, one month, or any other amount of time.

Most web browsers save all cookies in a single file. This file is located in a different directory for each browser and is not meant to be opened manually. Fortunately, most browsers allow you to view your cookies in the browser preferences, typically within the “Privacy” or “Security” tab.

Some browsers allow you to delete specific cookies or even prevent cookies from being created. While disallowing cookies in your browser may provide a higher level of privacy, it is not recommended, since many websites require cookies to function properly.

Note: Since cookies are stored in different locations for each web browser, if you switch browsers, new cookies will need to be created.

2. WHERE DOES TQ USE COOKIES?

On your computer, mobile device, smart phone or tablet.

We may also obtain and receive information stored by cookies from other domains used by TQ or TQ related entities.

3. WHY DOES TQ USE COOKIES?

From time to time we may use cookies for the following reasons:

- a) So we can remember who you are and your preferences;
- b) To validate a User's identity as they browse from page to page;
- c) To ensure we provide you with the best experience we can; and
- d) When you show interest in certain posts we that information to maintain the quality of future content.

4. WHAT DO YOU WANT AND HOW ARE YOU USING YOUR SITE?

Cookies assist us in gathering research in what and how you are using TQ. We also get to utilize your information to make your experience of using your device as best as possible.

Cookies can help us protect you and your continued use of our site. We can get information that helps us make security as optimized as we can by being able to identify information relating to potential threats to your and our accounts. It also assists us in ensuring we can help you to recover your information should you lose your password and you need to obtain new passwords to recover your information. We can remember browsers and information to help verify your account.

The above are some of the reasons but not all of the reasons we use cookies. As a user, you acknowledge and agree to TQ using cookies for the above and any additional reasons TQ may require to use cookies to gain information.

At all times the gathering of information will not breach TQ's Privacy Policy, our obligations under the *Privacy Act 1998* (Cth) nor the additional rights provided to Users located in the European Union (**EU**) under the General Data Protection Regulations (**GDPR**). We really need you to know this.

5. WILL ANYONE ELSE USE COOKIES ON TQ'S SITE?

Yes. Companies and partners engaged by TQ may use Cookies on the TQ website and App to gather knowledge and data on how the App is used and to identify any issues which may arise and to record user usage information so that we can provide an excellent user experience.

6. MANAGING COOKIES IN YOUR BROWSER

You can disable the cookies that we attach, if your browser supports this. For further information on how to do this please visit your “Settings” and follow the information.

As each browser is different, please visit your preferred browser to change the cookies settings should you so wish to. Please check the “Help” menu of your particular browser. Examples of browsers are Google, Yahoo, Firefox etc.

7. IDENTIFIERS

When you use mobile devices such as tablets or smartphones to access our App we may access your device, monitor your search content, collect and/or remotely store one or more “device identifiers.”

8. WHAT IS A DEVICE IDENTIFIER?

Small data files or data structures stored on or associated with your mobile device. These uniquely identify your mobile device. An identifier might be data stored in the devices hardware, data stored in connection with the devices operating system or other software or data that TQ has sent to your specific device.

Various identifiers including advertising identifiers, unique application identifiers, unique device Identifiers.

What the identifier will do is send this information it has gathered to TQ, TQ’s associated company such as On Point Holdings or third party associates providing us or them with information on how you browse our site/App and content you have looked at or services you use so we can provide you with content relevant to your search history.

9 WEB ANALYTICS

TQ uses Google Analytics, a web analysis service provided by Google Inc (“Google”). Google Analytics uses cookies to help our Website analyse how visitors use it. The information generated by the cookie about your use of our Website (including your IP address) will be transmitted to and stored by Google on servers in the United States or service locations as used by Google.

Google will use this information for the purpose of evaluating your use of the TQ website; compiling reports on activity for our operators to support the provision of other services related to Internet usage. Google may also transfer this information to third parties where required to do so by law or where such third parties process information on Google’s behalf. Google will not associate your IP address with any other data it holds.

More information including technical information about Google Analytics cookie usage can be found on the cookie section of Google’s website along with a copy of Google’s privacy policy.

By using TQ on your mobile device or website, you consent to the processing of data about you by Google in the manner described in Google's privacy policy and for the purposes set out above. You can opt out of Google Analytics, if you disable or refuse the Cookie, disable Java Script or use the Opt Out Service provided by Google.

TQ also has its own analytics tools that it uses to gather information such as:

- Access times of when you have been using TQ and on what device.
- What pages you have visited, videos you have watched or advertisements viewed for example.
- Your IP address.
- How you are using our services.
- Device Information including what operating system or web browser type you are using.
- Language.
- App crash reporting.
- Identifiers associated with Cookies or other technologies that identify your device or browser information.
- Pages you visit, advertisements you watch, websites you visit.

The analytics information referred to above will also be accessed by the TQ associated entities such as On Point Holdings being our marketing company. By accepting the TQ Cookies Policy and our Terms and Conditions you are agreeing and acknowledging that you understand the above.

TQ reserves its rights to substitute third party analytics providers and will advise you should we do so.

10 THIRD PARTY WEBSITES

Because we want your experience of our site to be as informative and useful as possible, we may provide links to websites operated by third parties ("Third Party Websites"). Please be aware that we do not control such third party websites and that such third party websites may send their own cookies to users, or otherwise collect data or solicit personal information.

By the way, when you visit these websites they most likely will ask you to accept their Terms and Conditions and Policies. It's up to you if you do or don't accept them; it's not our site; it's your choice.

We assume no responsibility for the information gathering practices of third party websites that you are able to access through our site, and we encourage you to review each Third Party websites Privacy Policy before disclosing any personally identifiable information.

We may also collect information that other users have provided about you from using our services.

Gathering all this information assist us in ensuring that we can provide you the best user experience when you are using TQ and direct information that we believe will be relevant to you.
